

## COLOURS CRITERIA

Colours are awarded to students in Years 7-12 for exemplary achievement. Colours may be embroidered onto the student blazer and therefore displayed at all formal occasions.

- School Colours (school representation) Royal Blue embroidery
- Half Colours (Regional, District Representation) White embroidery
- Full Colours (State Representation) Gold embroidery
- Shaw Honours (in honour of our Founding Chairman of the Board J.B. Shaw) (National Representation or other Exemplary Representation) Gold embroidery under the school crest and tie pin

Colours will be embroidered on blazers at Echidna Embroidery in Denham Street for a small fee. **No Colours are to be added without a letter of authorisation from the Principal's Office.**

**All colours are subject to students satisfying a minimum 80% attendance at training/ practice sessions and Games/ Competitions. Students must also have demonstrated a consistently high level of participation and excellence within the chosen area.** Academic Colours are awarded at Colours Assemblies held each Semester. All other colours are awarded at the end of the year. Students will receive the highest level of colour they are entitled to for each category.

Colours awarded will include:

### Academic Colours (awarded each Semester)

#### Academic School Colours

Not awarded

#### Academic Half Colours

Awarded to a student who achieves a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 12 (B+).

#### Academic Full Colours

Awarded to a student who achieves a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 13 (A-).

#### Academic Shaw Honours

Awarded to a Year 12 student who achieves the top placement in their subject (minimum VHA 10) in Queensland.

Awarded to a Year 12 student who receives an OP1.

Awarded to a student who achieves a medal award for National and International academic competitions (e.g. ICAS University of New South Wales (UNSW) Medals)

### Sporting Colours (awarded at Term 4 Colours Assembly)

#### Sporting School Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the school in individual or team sporting competitions/ events. The sport must have a weekly training regime and attendance rate of the student attending training is greater than 80%. Individual fixture/event quotas are detailed in the sporting colours table.

#### Sporting Half Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the school in a winning team in the Top Division Rockhampton competition/events where four or more competitors exist. The sport must have a weekly training regime and attendance rate of the student attending training is greater than 80%.
- Awarded to a student representing the school in an individual track and field or swimming event and placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Rockhampton or Capricornia level.
- Awarded to a student who makes a Capricornia or QLD Country Team.
- Awarded to a student who is selected for First Netball Team and/or First Touch Football Team (separate colours)

#### Sporting Full Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the school in a winning team at state/national level competition where four or more competitors exist
- Awarded to a student who is selected in a state team

#### Sport Shaw Colours

- Awarded to a student who is selected in a National team and beyond

### Community Colours (awarded at Term 4 Colours Assembly)

Community colours are awarded to students in Year 7-12 at the Term 4 Colours Assembly. To be eligible for colours, students must attend the compulsory events outlined in the Year Level Community Colours Table and reach the quota for each level.

#### Community School Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the school at 60% of community events, per year.
- Awarded to a student who coaches/ umpires at least 60% of games at an interschool level.

#### Community Half Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the school at 80% of community events, per year
- Awarded to a student who coaches/ umpires at least 80% of games at a regional level.

#### Community Full Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the school at 90% of community events, per year.
- Awarded to a student who coaches/ umpires at least 90% of games at a state level.

#### Community Shaw Honours

- Awarded to a student who has been recognised by a community organisation for their outstanding commitment to the organisation and has also qualified for Community Full Colours.
- Awarded to a student who coaches/ umpires at a national level.

## Cultural Colours

### Cultural School Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the School at cultural competitions, eisteddfods, or productions. The student must attend 80% of rehearsals during non-school hours and attend 100% of the events offered.
- Awarded to a student achieving a Credit in at least Grade IV AMEB practical, or Grade III AMEB theoretical examinations

### Cultural Half Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the School in a winning ensemble/ group at Rockhampton or regional level competition/ eisteddfod where four or more competitors exists. The student must attend 80% of rehearsals during non-school hours and attend 100% of the events offered.
- Awarded to student selected in a regional, state or national ensemble/choir/exhibition.
- Awarded to a student who is accepted into SHEP(local/state).
- Awarded to a student who achieves at least Honours in Grade V or higher AMEB practical, or Grade IV AMEB theoretical examinations.

### Cultural Full Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the School in a winning ensemble/ group at state/ national level competition/ eisteddfod where four or more competitors exists. The student must attend 80% of rehearsals during non-school hours and attend 100% of the events offered.
- Awarded to a student who is awarded a solo in a regional, state or national ensemble/choir/exhibition.
- Awarded to a student who has won a school approved, curated regional art competition with 4 or more competitors.
- Awarded to a student who is awarded a solo in SHEP (state).
- Awarded to a student who achieves a High Distinction in Grade VI or higher AMEB practical, or Grade V or higher AMEB theoretical.

### Cultural Shaw Honours

- Awarded to a student who achieves an AmusA or higher in AMEB examinations.
- Awarded to a student who has won a national art competition.

## Cattle Club Colours

To qualify for Cattle Club colours a student must:

- meet a minimum of 80% attendance at all Cattle Club meetings and shows
- be an active and reliable member of the Cattle Club Show Team

Points will be allocated for junior parading and judging as follows:

- First place three points
- Second place two points
- Third place one point
- Fourth place half a point

### Cattle Club School Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the School at Cattle Club attending >80% of training and available shows.

### Cattle Club Half Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the School at Cattle Club attending >80% of training and available shows.
- Awarded to a student representing the School at Cattle Club shows accumulating at least six points in the show season.

### Cattle Club Full Colours

- Awarded to a student representing the School at Cattle Club attending >80% of training and available shows.

- Awarded to a student representing the School at Cattle Club shows accumulating at least ten points in the show season.
- Awarded to a student placing top three in judging/ herdsman at Royal Brisbane Show.
- Awarded to a student who places first in judging/ herdsman at Royal Toowoomba or the Rockhampton Show.

**Cattle Club Shaw Honours**

- Awarded to a student placing first in judging/ herdsman at the Royal Brisbane Show.

**Individual Achievement Colours (for non-school teams/groups and achievement)**

\*Upon application to the Colours Committee only (by Term 4 Week 4) \*

**Individual Half Colours**

- Awarded to a student in a winning team at Rockhampton or regional sporting competitions.
- Awarded to a student who places first in a Rockhampton or regional competition/ eisteddfod.

**Individual Full Colours**

- Awarded to a student who qualifies for and is selected in a state team.
- Awarded to a student in a winning team at a state level sporting competition.
- Awarded to a student in placing first at state level competition/ eisteddfod.

**Individual Shaw Honours**

- Awarded to a student who is selected in a national sporting team.
- Awarded to a student who places in a national competition/ eisteddfod.
